

Paley Save-the-Limb Foundation benefit hears from orthopedic surgeon

The Flagler Steakhouse was the setting for the inaugural Palm Beach luncheon to benefit the Paley Save-the-Limb Foundation.

The event took place March 2.

Dr. Dror Paley, an orthopedic surgeon based at St. Mary's Medical Center, was the guest speaker at the luncheon. He spoke about his highly specialized field, dedicated to developing and teaching new techniques to save and reconstruct the limbs of children and adults.

Paley helped to develop procedures that, whenever possible, eliminate the need for amputation among those who suffer from rare limb deficiencies and other complex orthopedic conditions.

At the end of March, Paley will take a team on his second visit to Haiti to treat people who sustained limb injuries during last year's earthquake.

Anita Gabler was chairwoman of the event.

Proceeds benefited the Paley Save-the-Limb Foundation, a 501 (c3) tax-exempt organization established to help support his efforts.
